Goodwill recycles 9.5 million lbs yearly of stuff that didn't sell in stores. Of that, more than 2 million lbs of e-waste was recycled.

50k people will use Goodwill services in '10, a record! Services include job aid, car/school savings programs & health services.

Goodwill's Good Careers Academies help students get certified for in-demand jobs, such as IT & medical/nursing assistants.

Goodwill's Good Careers Academies help students get certified for in-demand jobs for a fraction of the cost of other schools!

Goodwill's best-in-class program has helped ex-offenders re-enter the community successfully for 5 years.

Every 300 people who successfully re-enter the community through Goodwill's ex-offender program save Bexar County \$6.2M!

The recidivism rate for Goodwill's award-winning ex-offender program is 8-9%. Nationally, the rate for similar programs is 44%.

Goodwill has been helping to change lives through the power of work in the SA community for 65 years.

Nearly 90 cents of every dollar spent at Goodwill funds its mission to help change lives through the power of work.

Goodwill is the 17th largest employer in the SA community, with nearly 1k team members.

Goodwill is the largest employer in the SA community for people with disabilities: 50% of its staff members have disabilities.

Goodwill holds gov't contracts for svcs like USAF record-keeping, mail & recycling centers & grounds maintenance @ local bases.

More than 75% of the people working on Goodwill's gov't contracts are a person with a disability!

Goodwill's Good Careers Academy for in-demand professions opened in '09, & now there are two locations w/five more planned.

The Good Careers Academies are partnerships w/Alamo Colleges to offer certifications in IT, health care & other in-demand professions.

Good Careers Academy case mgrs partner w/students to help them succeed, resulting in higher completion rates and lower costs!

With credit unions in stores, Goodwill shoppers can get low-cost banking svcs & avoid check-cashers, other high-interest lenders.
